

Readiness Checklist for ICD-10-CM Implementation

Have you ...?



- Formed a committee, tasked to spear-head the transition (different areas of practice financial, operational, clinical, etc.)
 - Developed an ICD-10 training plan for all areas of the practice*
- Evaluated/Updated your systems (EMR, Practice Management, etc.) in preparation for ICD-10
- Evaluated resources currently in place for coders/billing staff
- Reviewed budgets and/or prepared for projected “dip” in revenue and delayed claims after 10/1/15
- Begun or have plans to begin internal and external testing of claims
- Reviewed payer and vendor contracts
- Evaluated/revised forms/templates
- Evaluated/revised practice policies and procedures as appropriate
- Identified the most common codes assigned in the practice
 - Created or acquired an ICD-9 to ICD-10 mapping tool for training of providers*
 - Audited clinic and operative notes for training of providers regarding the required documentation to support the more detailed ICD-10 codes*
 - Educated or begun educating provider and staff, based on audit findings*
